CO-OPTION OF A PARISH COUNCILLOR TO ITCHINGFIELD PARISH COUNCIL

**Are you interested in local current affairs?
Do you wish to serve your community?
Could you provide a voice for residents?**

Itchingfield Parish Council is seeking to co-opt new Councillors. The person(s) co-opted to the Council will be required to sign a declaration that they will conform to the requirements of the Code of Conduct for Local Councillors.

The Parish Council meets monthly on a Monday.

To qualify as a Co-Opted Councillor, a person must be either:

- A British Citizen or an eligible Commonwealth citizen

And:

- 18 years or over
- Not disqualified by any statute

And:

- Be an elector of the Parish or
- Has resided in the Parish for the past twelve months or rented/tenanted land or other premises in the Parish, or
- Has their principle place of work in the Parish, or
- Lives within three miles of the Parish boundary
