

Itchingfield Parish Council views safe & effective roads as vital.

We therefore support appropriate road use & functional infrastructure, and will promote these in partnership with road users & relevant organisations.

Factors connected with use include traffic speed, volume, type & behaviour. These vary by location, over time and in response to an evolving traffic environment.

Infrastructure considers such elements as design, build, maintenance & modification of the road network, and also support, monitoring and control measures.

By road users, we think of both vehicles (cars, vans, lorries, buses, motorbikes, bicycles, tractors, for example) and non-vehicles (walkers, horseriders, among others).

Relevant organisations are such bodies as district, county (and by extension, national) government, emergency & utility services, schools, Parish special interest groups, local businesses, and neighbouring parishes. We recognise also the stake of the Parish community as a whole.

Actions and decisions of IPC around Traffic and Road Use will take into account the above points.
